

8 Graces Study Group Start Up Guide

What are 8 Graces Study Groups?

- 8 Graces Study Groups are designed to facilitate couples in learning and practicing The 8 Graces of Marriage, primarily through discussions based on the short videos introducing core concepts.
- Practicing *The 8 Graces of Marriage* can revolutionize the way a couple interacts, solves conflicts, and works as a team by creating a culture of grace in their marriage. This study can also equip couples for mentoring other couples.

Starting a 8 Graces Study Group

- While the material is not hard to complete in a short time, we have found it is best learned when a group of 3-4 couples work slowly over several months, one or two graces at a time, discussing together and then practicing each grace at home.
- If there are more than 4-5 couples, we suggest **breaking into smaller groups** to better facilitate discussions.
- The advantages of group format include the mutual encouragement, accountability and peer mentoring gained from other couples sharing stories in their grace journeys and praying for one another.
- The 10 teaching videos run 15-20 min. each. Ideally couples gather in one location and stream the video together directly from the website (ie. SmartTV or computer hooked up to a TV or projector).

- Each participant will need to download the 8 Graces Participant Study
 Guide pdf which includes a summary of the video teaching content and both
 group and couple specific discussion questions.
- Format ideas for working through this material:
 - A group creates their own schedule and pace for working through the material, meeting weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly.
 - Meetings can occur at a church while child care is provided (Sun.,Wed.), in someone's home, or even using an online format.
 - Formats can vary to suit each group's schedule. For example, a gathering could involve simply watching a Teaching Video all together and beginning group discussion questions. The next 1-2 gatherings might include continuing the discussion questions or sharing how applying one or more of the graces is going. Another gathering time could be a fun event together.

FAQ

• Does someone need to be an experienced small group leader or marriage expert to lead a 8 Graces Study Group?

No, this course is designed so that groups can learn together.

- What is the ideal venue for the study group?
 - A room with a large enough screen for the group to watch the streaming videos all together
 - A venue layout that facilitates group discussions
- Do participants download the videos to view later?
 No, the only material participants have for personal study is the downloadable e-booklet.
- Do couples need to be Christians to participate in the study? No, but anyone invited to participate should know that the material is based on principles from the Bible.
- Do participants need to print anything out for the sessions?
 No, they can view the e-book on their phones or tablets, but they can bring a notebook for taking extra notes.
